1. THE START

The starting line shall be between the staff displaying an orange flag on the committee vessel, anchored near Largs Yacht Haven, and an orange inflatable race mark.

2. THE COURSE

2.1 The Course for Classes 1 and 2 only is as follows:

CLASSES 1 and 2 ONLY Approx 38NM	
Mark	Direction
Start Line	Cross South to North
Great Cumbrae Island	Pass to PORT
"Hun1" Nav Buoy (yellow)	Pass to PORT
Yellow Inflatable Race Mark (approx. position 55°31.88N, 05°03.25W)	Pass to PORT
"Hun 14" Nav Buoy (red)	Pass to PORT
"Hun 9" Nav Buoy (red)	Pass to PORT
Finish Line	Cross South to North

2.2 The course for Classes 3 and 4 is as follows:

CLASSES 3 and 4 ONLY Approx 20NM	
Mark	Direction
Start Line	Cross South to North
"F" Nav Buoy (red)	Pass to PORT
"No 13" Isolated Danger Beacon (red, black, red)	Pass to PORT
"Portachur" Nav Buoy (green)	Pass to PORT
"Little Cumbrae Island"	Pass to PORT
"Hun 14" Nav Buoy (red)	Pass to PORT
"Hun 9" Nav Buoy (red)	Pass to PORT
Finish Line	Cross South to North

3. THE FINISH

- 3.1 The finishing line shall be between a flagpole displaying a blue flag on the Largs SC building and a blue inflatable race mark, located approximately 0.4NM to the west of LSC.
- 3.2 **SHORTENED COURSE:** The course may be shortened at any mark of the course in accordance with RRS 32.2 or, in addition, at an inflatable buoy (that is not necessarily a pre-defined mark of the course) laid specifically for shortening the course. In the event of a shortened course boats shall finish between a committee vessel displaying flag "S" and the adjacent mark, the location of any such finishing line will be announced regularly by VHF.
- 3.3 **TIME LIMITS:** The time limit for all classes is 2000. If one boat in a class finishes within the time limit the time limit will be extended by one hour for other boats in that class. Boats failing to finish within the time limit, and not subsequently retiring, penalized or given redress, will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE) without a hearing. A boat scored TLE shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the points scored by the last boat that finished within the time limit. This changes RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10
