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Race 8 Courses

1. THE START

The starting line shall be between the staff displaying an orange flag on the committee vessel and an orange inflatable race mark. The location of the start line will be advised by Telegram.

2. THE COURSE

The courses for all classes will be created from the list of marks shown in Appendix I of the Sailing instructions and additional inflatable race marks may also be used. The course will be advised either at the briefing or later by Telegram.

3. THE FINISH

The finishing line shall be between a staff or flagpole displaying a blue flag and an inflatable race mark. The location of the finish line will be advised by Telegram.

- 3.1 **SHORTENED COURSE:** The course may be shortened at any mark of the course in accordance with RRS 32.2 or, in addition, at an inflatable buoy (that is not necessarily a pre-defined mark of the course) laid specifically for shortening the course. In the event of a shortened course boats shall finish between a committee vessel displaying flag "S" and the adjacent mark, the location of any such finishing line will be announced regularly by VHF.

If a race is abandoned the times taken from a previous round may be used to calculate results.

- 3.2 **TIME LIMITS:** The time limit for all classes is 1700. If one boat in a class finishes within the time limit the time limit will be extended by one hour for other boats in that class. Boats failing to finish within the time limit, and not subsequently retiring, penalized or given redress, will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE) without a hearing. A boat scored TLE shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the points scored by the last boat that finished within the time limit. This changes RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10
